| <p>DISTINGUISHING CHARACTERISTICS</p> <p>The Office of the County Agricultural Commissioner-Sealer of Weights and Measures combines the functions of agricultural inspection and weights and measures to perform the services, inspections and controls required by law. The <u>Deputy Agricultural Commissioner</u> is a management level position which coordinates and supervises the agricultural inspection activities of the department. Incumbents plan, organize, train and supervise the activities of a staff of Agricultural and Standards Inspectors engaged in agricultural inspection and enforcement work. The <u>Deputy Sealer of Weights & Measures</u> is a management level position which coordinates and supervises the weights and measures inspection activities in all phases of the enforcement of Division 5 of the California Business and Professions Code at the county level. Incumbents plan, organize, train and supervise the activities of a staff of Agricultural and Standards Inspectors engaged in weights and measures inspection and enforcement work. The <u>Deputy Agricultural Commissioner-Sealer</u> is a management level position which assistst the Commissioner-Sealer in the overall operations of the department. Incumbents are assigned primary responsibility for one or more functional ares within the combined functions of agriculture and weights and measures.</p> | | | | | |

DEPUTY SEALER OF WEIGHTS & MEASURES

Experience: Three years of technical experience in agricultural inspection and enforcement, with at least one year of experience as a an Agricultural and Standards Inspector III in Kings County or equivalent.

Licenses: Possession of:

- 1) A valid California License of Eligibility as a County Deputy Sealer of Weights & Measures *(copy of license must be submitted with application); and,*
- 2) A valid, appropriate California driver's license issued by the Department of Motor Vehicles.

DEPUTY AGRICULTURAL COMMISSIONER-SEALER

Experience: Three years of technical experience in agricultural and/or weights and measures inspection and enforcement, with at least one year of experience as an Agricultural and Standards Inspector III in Kings County or equivalent.

Licenses: Possession of:

- 1) A valid California License of Eligibility as a County Deputy Agricultural Commissioner *(copy of license must be submitted with application); and*
- 2) A valid California License of Eligibility as a County Deputy Sealer of Weights and Measures; *(copy of license must be submitted with application) and,*
- 3) A valid, appropriate California driver's license issued by the Department of Motor Vehicles.

Special Requirements: Depending on the operational needs of the department: (1) Ability to work irregular hours in an outdoors environment under changing weather and temperature conditions;
(2) ability to walk two miles or more on uneven terrain; ability to lift, carry or move objects weighing up to 50 pounds.
(3) Based on assignment or in a training capacity, incumbents may be required to handle and discharge firearms necessary for the control of wildlife, operate off-road vehicles, and/or handle, mix, load and apply chemical controls for weeds, rodents, and other pests or diseases.

SELECTION PROCESS:

Depending upon the number of applicants who meet the minimum qualifications, the examination process may include a qualifications screening (pass/fail) and/or an oral examination (100%) to determine placement on the eligible list.
